Parkland team members are currently eligible to receive 15 days of complimentary, backup childcare* (ages 0-6 years old) at Annie's Place, the childcare center of the nonprofit Mommies in Need.

*Backup care includes:

- Change in work schedules
- School/Daycare holidays and closures (children may not be in quarantine because of COVID exposure)
- Primary care provider illness/vacation (i.e. nanny, grandparent, etc.)

Services Provided

- Up to 15 days a calendar year of complimentary childcare for children ages 0-6 years old; if space is available during school holidays and vacations school age children can be accommodated
 - If additional days are needed, please contact the Office of Talent Management ([OTM Service Portal](#), 469-419-3000, ext. 7-3000).
- Specially trained bilingual teachers and staff, including social workers and play therapists
- Comprehensive, research-based curriculum that is offered in both English and Spanish
- Healthy snacks and a hot lunch
- Diapers
- Formula or breast milk can be stored onsite for bottle-fed children

How To Enroll

- When the enrollment form is open, under the section titled "I was referred to Annie's Place by," choose "other" and write in "Parkland Employee."
- After completing the enrollment form, a member of Annie’s Place staff will be in touch by phone to complete the process (Please allow 1-2 days for the process to be complete).

Requirements

Children must be well, fever-free and not in isolation/quarantine per current CDC guidelines on the day of the childcare appointment. Household members also must not be COVID-19 positive or symptomatic.

On your child’s first day, you must provide current immunization records and a professional healthcare statement.
